SESSIONS – The content of a typical session can be adapted for your classroom!

Daycare & Preschool: During a 20-minute session Karel will read *Snowflake Comes to Stay*; lead the children in a drawing game; read *Who's Been Here?: A Tale of Tracks* and ask children to guess the animals that make each track. Karel will end the session with a sing-a-long of *If You Want to Find a Bear, Clap Your Hands*.

Kindergarten: A 45-minute visit will follow the format of the Daycare & Preschool visit and include a PowerPoint show about Karel's studio, pets and work.

1st – 3rd Grades: A 45-minute session includes a PowerPoint show and talk about what it takes to write a story. Karel will read *Who's Been Here: A Tale of Tracks* or her most recent book. She will play a drawing game, Stump the Artist, and end with questions and answers from students and teachers.

Older Students: Get inspired by the artist! With over 30 years of experience, Karel will talk about the life of a professional artist. Students will learn about the variety of work she does and discuss how she develops ideas from early drafts to publication. Karel can also show students how to make a story into a book.
